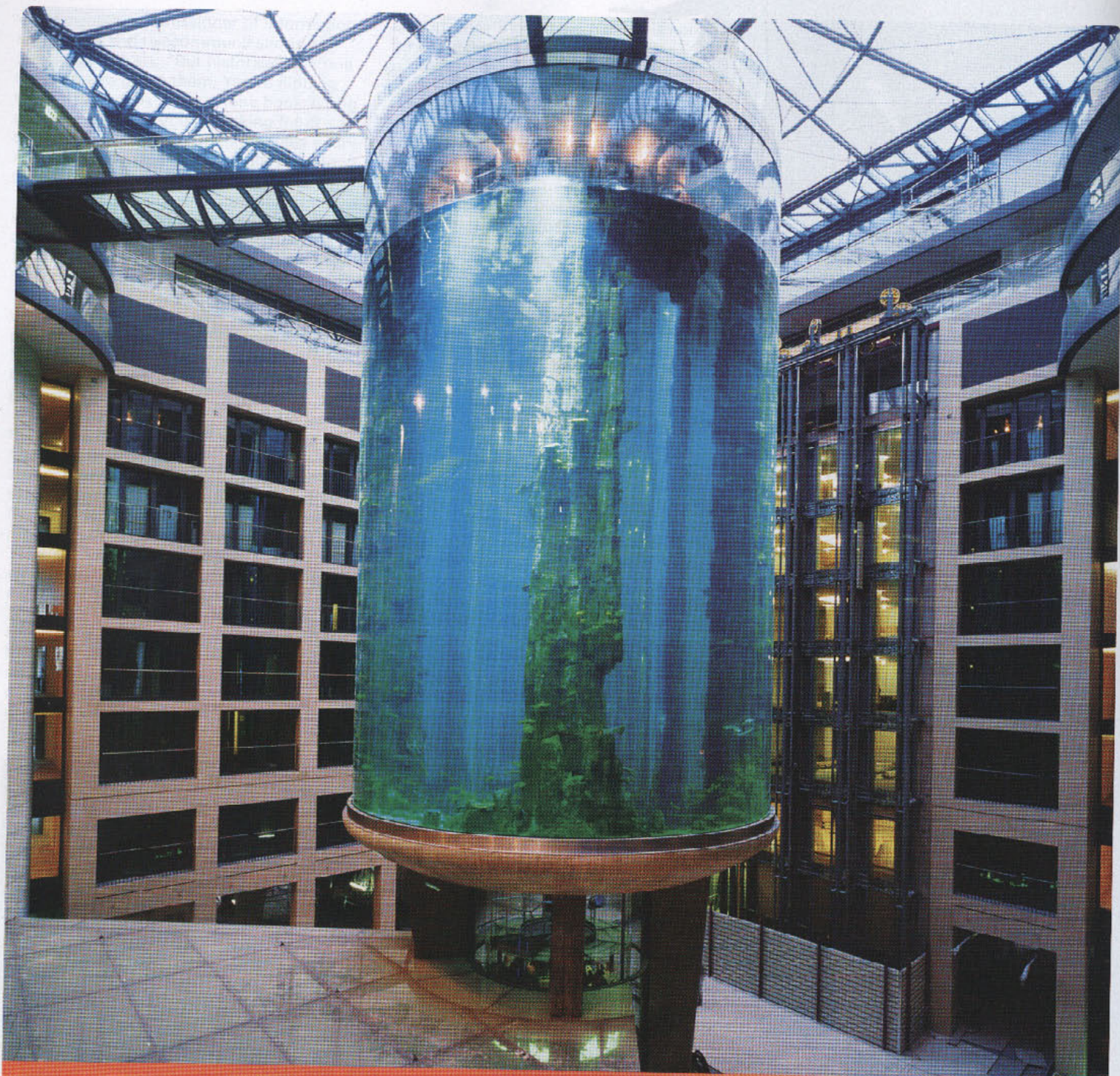

Sleep With the Fishes

A Berlin hotel is giving new meaning to the phrase "life in a fish bowl." The new DomAquaree Radisson houses the world's deepest aquarium, the Aquadom. The eight-story tank affords guest rooms some incredible views: In addition to watching 50 species of fish, visitors who take the seven-minute elevator ride through the underwater world will likely spot housekeeping hard at work. Though a filtration system recirculates all 264,000 gallons of water every 40 minutes, a trio of divers must clean algae off the acrylic tube and coral by hand. The designer, International Concept Management (known for its shark tanks at Mandalay Bay in Las Vegas), plans to build an even deeper aquarium in Moscow next year. It could make the Aquadom look like a guppy. — Stuart Luman
